



Beauty coming from the past:

# Turnalit Beige and Turnalit Coral

Petma Marble, founded as a subsidiary of Pet Holding that has been serving in various sectors in Turkey and abroad for 38 years, has made an ambitious entry to natural stone market in 2010.

Petma General Manager Zeynep Köksal Yaykiran stated that Petma Marble produces Turnalit Beige and Turnalit Coral marble blocks in Turhal town of Tokat since 2010 and said: "Our middle term plan is to offer our customers a wider scope of products by expanding our product range. And for this, we are looking into new quarries."

## Project Stones

General Manager Köksal Yaykiran said they are currently working on the second and third levels in the quarry and produce light beige colour Turnalit Marble blocks that acquire their name from the regions former names. We classify these blocks in two different selections as Turnalit Beige and Turnalit Coral. Turnalit Coral blocks have thin red veins and just like Turnalit Beige blocks, they possess strong and homogeneous export block quality. Both selections are highly

demanding by both national and international project companies for their light beige and homogenous colour unique to the region."

## Our production goal is 5 thousand cubic meters.

Yaykiran said: "We aim to produce 5 thousand cubic meters in 2013 and emphasized that this goal can easily be increased according to the demand. We are able to achieve this due to the homogenous colour of our blocks and to the fact that we are able to acquire very large and strong blocks (4 Mohs). At the moment, we produce and export our stones as blocks. On the other hand, we began producing materials for significant and influential foreign and national projects by cutting our stones to sizes in capable factories. Along with the world's biggest block purchasers, China, and India; we supply to Lebanon, Israel, Azerbaijan, Qatar, Egypt, Jordan and some EU Countries."
